PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Neighbors,

We arrived safely back home to Florida for the winter and spring but were unprepared for the extent of the damages to our overall community. We watched the news from up north, but it didn't really present the complete picture for the Ponte Vedra Beach and St. Augustine communities. Our hearts go out to all of our friends who have been negatively impacted by the power of Mother Nature and the storm effects. I am told that a storm of this magnitude has not impacted this area since 1964 – over a half-century.

I have sent out a lengthy update letter last week to our general membership about our clubhouse progress but was reminded today that not all members have access to email. The latest news is as follows: The roof has been repaired and is now water tight thanks to the individual efforts of Ed Olsen, Ken McGill and Larry Sachs. The costs incurred were far less than a professional roofer would have charged. We are preparing to do the interior ceiling repair work and are having trouble matching tile colors since the ceiling tiles are no longer available. We will put plastic over the ceiling this week to prevent anything more falling while we commence with our interior work. Additional exterior work like repairing the railings and replacing soffit sections will follow later after we complete the general clubhouse repairs. While this is going on, the clubhouse has OFFICIALLY REOPENED. Members will still need to avoid the section of the room where the ceiling damage has taken place. A blue tarp is on the floor indicating where to avoid.

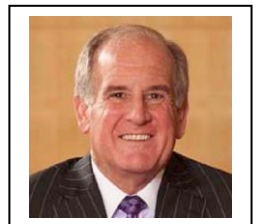
Despite the hurricane, our long-awaited new sewer drain field is scheduled to be installed this coming Thursday. This will provide a permanent solution to our sewer and sanitation issues for many years to come. For some reason the water was turned off to the women's bathroom this past week. We have no idea how that happened but it is back on now.

We are planning on having the Oktoberfest Dinner, which was planned for the second Friday in October (but cancelled due to the hurricane), substitute for the 2nd Friday Potluck Dinner in November. I have not specifically spoken to Caroline Fusco about "Trivia Challenge" but assume it will take place during the November dinner.

We don't normally play Bingo in November and December because of the holidays, but since we moved the night back to the 3rd Wednesday of the month, we should be able to play in November. I am willing and able to call the game and so will declare us ready to go in November on Wednesday, Nov 16 at 7 pm. Come ready to win big money and help us usher in the Thanksgiving Holiday.

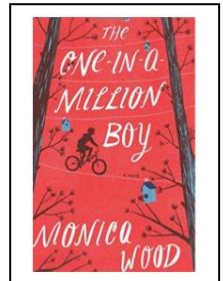
